

Checklist of Required Documentation for the Lending Integrity Seal of Approval Application:

Please include the following information/documentation:

- 1) NAMB & NEAMB membership completed and accepted.
- 2) Three (3), fully executed "Industry Reference Letters". At least one of them must be provided by a current NAMB / NEAMB member in good standing.
- 3) "Completion certificate" for the National Background Check.
- 4) Copies of applicable continuing education "certificates". You must attend at least 6 hours (or equivalent) of professional development education and at least 2 hours (or equivalent) of ethics training every year.
- 5) Signed and fully executed "***Application Cover Letter***" to State Director.
- 6) Signed and fully executed "***Penalty of Perjury Affidavit***"
- 7) Proof of payment of NAMB Special Assessment – Applicable if you became a member prior to June 1, 2008.

The NEAMB Ethics Committee and Board of Directors will review your application. If NEAMB accepts and approves your application, it will be forwarded (with NEAMB's recommendation) to NAMB for final approval. This process may take approximately 4-6 weeks.
